



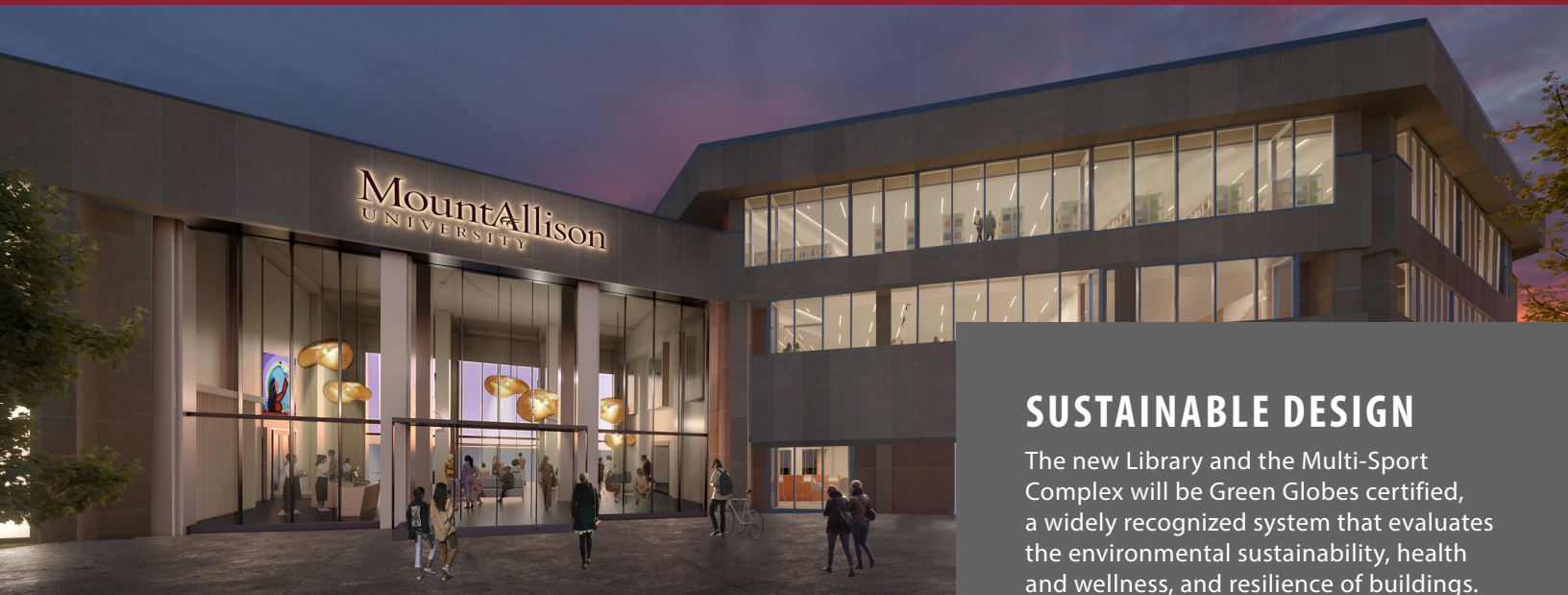

Our University community has launched an historic building project — to extensively renovate the R.P. Bell Library and create a new Multi-Sport Complex. This project supports all aspect of student life and will have transformative impacts on future generations.

The new Library and the Multi-Sport Complex will be Green Globes certified, a widely recognized system that evaluates the environmental sustainability, health and wellness, and resilience of buildings.

THE LIBRARY: SPACE TO TEACH, LEARN, DISCOVER, AND CONNECT

The renovation of the R.P. Bell Library building is the largest infrastructure project in Mount Allison's modern history. The new building will include extensive renovations at every level, the transformation of the adjacent breezeway into a coffee and community space, and new welcoming and accessible entrances from both the quad and York street levels.

The R.P. Bell Library Centre for Innovation and Learning will be home to library services, materials, special collections, and expertise. It will provide a place for quiet study and spirited discussion, for individual learning and community intersections, and for intense work and unwinding with friends. Plans include spaces to support entrepreneurship, data and digital scholarship, and customizable study.

Although a built space, this project is above all about people. It will support students and bring together groups of thinkers, innovators, and the always curious. It will deliver learning spaces and resources that spark interdisciplinary collaboration, entrepreneurial thinking, and new forms of research, teaching, and engagement. The building will become an even more integral and valued part of every student's experience.

The Library is being designed in close consultation with students, alumni, Indigenous leaders, and faculty and staff. Together, we will build a place where connections are forged, where different approaches to learning are embraced and respected, and where all community members are inspired to broaden their knowledge and reach for ambitious goals. It will be a defining feature of Mount Allison.

MULTI-SPORT COMPLEX: ACCESSIBLE, HIGH-QUALITY SPORTS AND RECREATION FACILITIES

The Multi-Sport Complex will house facilities for a variety of sports and recreation activities including intramural and club sports, be utilized 12 months a year, support all students, and provide a new venue for Mount Allison and community events.

This facility will begin its life as an interim library facility while the R.P. Bell Library building undergoes extensive renovations and will then be transformed into a permanent sports and recreation complex.

There is a tremendous need on our campus for expanded athletic resources. For students, sports and recreation provide invaluable opportunities for learning and growth outside the classroom. What starts often as a break from academic studies becomes a passion for health and wellness, the fostering of lifelong healthy habits, and unique opportunities to develop teamwork, leadership, and other social skills, along with resiliency and discipline.

By investing in the Multi-Sport Complex, we will encourage students and everyone in our community to lead active lifestyles. We will further promote a culture of wellness and self-care on campus.
